These programs position students for lifelong success through skills attainment, progress through career pathways, and access to sustainable and increasing living wages.

Last year, 75 percent of Job Corps' nearly 50,000 enrollees entered employment or higher education after leaving the program. Job Corps is a tuition-free training and education program that connects eligible young men and women with the skills and educational opportunities they need to establish real careers. Horizons Youth Services helps connect students with Job Corps programs across the United States.
